

Evry Cathedral

This cathedral is a rare example of one having been built in 20th-century in France. The entire building is in brick. The design of the interior walls was studied and developed using absorption measurements in the Peutz laboratory. The cathedral has reverberant characteristics but, with electro-acoustic support, allows for good intelligibility.
